

The Naturalization Process

Preparation

- · Confirm your eligibility to naturalize
- Collect personal data including immigration and travel history
- Collect required documents
- Draft naturalization application

File Application

- Review application with attorney
- Submit application to government
- Receive confirmation of successful filing

Biometrics Appointment

- Government assigns appointment to appear for fingerprinting
- Attend biometrics appointment and keep your stamped receipt

Monitor Pending Case

- Check case status periodically on uscis.gov
- Study materials for the civics and English tests
- Prepare for the interview
- Respond to any government requests for additional information

Interview

- · Government assigns you an interview date
- Interview covers eligibility
- Civics and English tests are given during the interview

Oath Ceremony

- Government assigns you an oath ceremony date
- At the ceremony you formally become a U.S. citizen
- The ceremony is a fun event open to you and your guests, so bring family and friends to celebrate with you

Update Paperwork

- Apply for a U.S. Passport
- Register to vote
- Notify the Social Security Administration
- Update your paperwork with your employer
- Update IDs if you changed your name
- Consider petitioning for relatives
